

Youth Art Month 2012 at the Worcester Art Museum

This multi-media exhibit is sponsored by the Massachusetts Art Education Association as part of Youth Art Month, a national celebration to emphasize the value of art education for all children and to encourage support for the quality art programs in Massachusetts' schools.

Youth Art Month will be celebrated with a Youth Reception on Sunday, March 11, for the young exhibitors, grades kindergarten through grade eight, and their families. Admission is free in the Higgins Education wing of the Worcester Art Museum, which will be open Tuesday through Friday from 9AM to 5PM and on Saturday from 10AM to 3PM.
