Maryland's Tips for nominating NAEA (national) award winners (presentation by Riselle Abrams):

State awards modeled on national

(They have **Arts Coordinators/Supervisors** from each region of their association on their Board/nominating committee – it seems that's how they get a lot of their awards nominees...not just from general membership...)

Appoint a National awards coordinator (good idea, but on our small board, probably not feasible to have a separate one – although that's basically what we did have since Carol did all the National nomination work this past year)

Compile a list of previous award winners (word doc. For easy emailing) (SOMETHING WE HAVE TO DO ASAP)

Email winners list and award categories to every board member in May

Set deadline for nominations to be returned in early June

Stage an online or email vote

Review

Their State awards....by October

Pull from pool of State awardees for National awards

Try to get copies of National scoring rubrics for awards... Call NAEA???
